The mission of the Tulsa Historical Society is to illuminate the past, enrich the present, and inspire future generations by collecting, preserving, and presenting Tulsa's history. Established in 1963, the Tulsa Historical Society holds an extensive collection of resources on our city's rich past. The collection contains nearly 5,000 still photographs, books, maps, documents, graphics, historical costumes and architectural remnants, and fine and decorative arts. The Society is currently in the process of adapting the Travis Mansion into its future home. The house will serve as the Society's headquarters and will provide space for a comprehensive museum on Tulsa's history with exhibits formed from the organization's permanent collections. Renovations are expected to be complete in September 2007.
