

Tulsa Transit Rack-N-Roll Program

The goal of the Rack-N-Roll program is to improve mobility in the Tulsa Transit service area. The Rack-N-Roll Program allows eligible Tulsa Transit customers to borrow a Tulsa Transit owned bicycle to be used in conjunction with their transit commutes. Upon acceptance into the program, program participants may check out a bicycle at the Denver Avenue Station (DAS – 319 S. Denver Ave.) and use it for up to 24 hours at NO CHARGE before returning it. Application must be submitted in person with proper ID at DAS during hours noted. DAS customer service hours: 7 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. weekdays, closed on Saturdays and Sundays.

Program Rules

- 1) Applicant must be at least 18 years of age with verifiable employment and must supply a valid personal photo ID (Official Oklahoma Photo ID Card or Oklahoma Driver's License).
- 2) All program participants will receive (and must show) a valid Rack-N-Roll ID card to check out a program bicycle. Participant is fully responsible for the bicycle until returning it.
- 3) All program equipment (bike, lock, key) must be returned to DAS within 24-hours of the original check-out time during customer service hours. Participants who do not check program bicycles back in within this period are subject to a late fee of \$25 per day, and removal from the program. No returns on Saturday or Sunday. Bikes checked out on a Friday must be returned before 11 a.m. Monday.
- 4) Participant is responsible for fully compensating Tulsa Transit for the cost of any lost or damaged program equipment. Theft of Tulsa Transit property will result in criminal prosecution and loss of all bus riding privileges.
- 5) Upon checking out a program bicycle, participants must examine the bicycle for mechanical problems that would make operation of the bicycle unsafe (things such as flat tires, non-working brakes, etc.)
