Janitorial Service Amendment #2
October 2, 2017

This amendment provides additional information to firms responding to RFP #18-1805 Janitorial Service issued by the Metropolitan Tulsa Transit Authority (Tulsa Transit).

Purpose: This amendment adds an additional task to the Scope of Work.

Addition

1. All ceiling light fixtures will be cleaned once a year. Opening up the fixture doors/covers (may require pliers and/or screwdriver). Once the fixture is open, clean the fixture inside and out with damp cloth. If necessary use an all-purpose cleaning solution. Please note this task will require high ladder work (up to a 12 foot step ladder). Ladder(s) to be supplied by contractor.
2. Stripping , buffing and waxing on the original RFP did not include the Call Center and Maintenance Office VCT tile. It should include this on the same time basis as indicated in the RFP.
3. The day porter requirement requires that there be two porters, one male and one female, Monday through Sunday, during normal daytime business hours. Normal daytime business hours are 7AM to 6PM Monday through Friday and 8AM to 5PM on Sunday.
4. Tulsa Transit desires that the janitorial representative at the stations wear some kind of uniform so they are easily identified as janitorial contractors.
